**To be on track for graduation...**



You should have **30** credits by now

You should have **60** credits by the end of 9<sup>th</sup> grade

You need **220** TOTAL CREDITS FOR GRADUATION

# College: Minimum Admission Requirements

- A. History and Social Science: 2 years
- B. English : 4 years
- C. Mathematics: 3 years passing IM3 (4 years recommended)
- D. Lab Science: 2 years (3 years recommended)
- E. Language Other Than English: 2 years of the same language
- F. Visual & Performing Art: 1 year
- G. College Prep Elective: 1 year (anything extra in A-F, or a G category course)

Must have C- or higher in all A-G courses

CSU: 2.0 minimum GPA to apply

UC: 3.0 minimum GPA to apply

# Consider these things as you choose courses...

- Balance between easy and difficult classes.
- What else is going on during Sophomore year?
- AP courses:
  - Consider the rigor and homework load
  - What should I do if the class is too hard?
  - Summer homework?
  - Do I need summer school?
- *Grades are very important in 10<sup>th</sup> grade! Colleges will be looking at your sophomore year grades!*

# Math & Foreign Language

- It's suggested that you earn a C or higher to move up to the next level.
- Remember: You must pass 2 years of a foreign language (minimum) to be 4 year college qualified.

- Do I need summer school?
  - You may if...
    - You received an F in a core course and need to gain credits
    - You received a D in a course and received credits, but would like to maintain A-G eligibility
    - You want to complete health or PE in the summer
- If any of these apply to you and you haven't seen me to enroll yet, please see a counselor once you are done with your course requests.

# Filling Out Your Course Requests

1. Circle either ENGLISH 2 or HONORS ENGLISH 2
2. Circle either WORLD HISTORY or AP WORLD HISTORY
3. Circle your MATHEMATICS course
4. Circle your World Language course
5. Choose PE 2 or an ELECTIVE
6. Choose a SCIENCE or an ELECTIVE
7. Choose an ELECTIVE Health, SS Elective, Civitas, Medical Careers, art, band, engineering, wood or drama  
Zero period options: Jazz, or PE 2

# Choose Your Course Requests

**Step 1:** Complete the **yellow** form and write in alternates.

**Step 2:** Log-in to your San Juan Portal

A. Click on the 10<sup>th</sup> grade picture of yourself.

B. Click "Requests" and then click "Add/Delete Requests".

C. When you have 6 classes (60. credits), Click "Submit" and logout.

**Step 3:** Give your **yellow** form to a counselor **TODAY**.

**Step 4:** Talk with your parent/guardian about your courses, and make changes in Q if necessary for up to 1 week. After April 15th, any changes must be made with Mrs. Wilson.
