

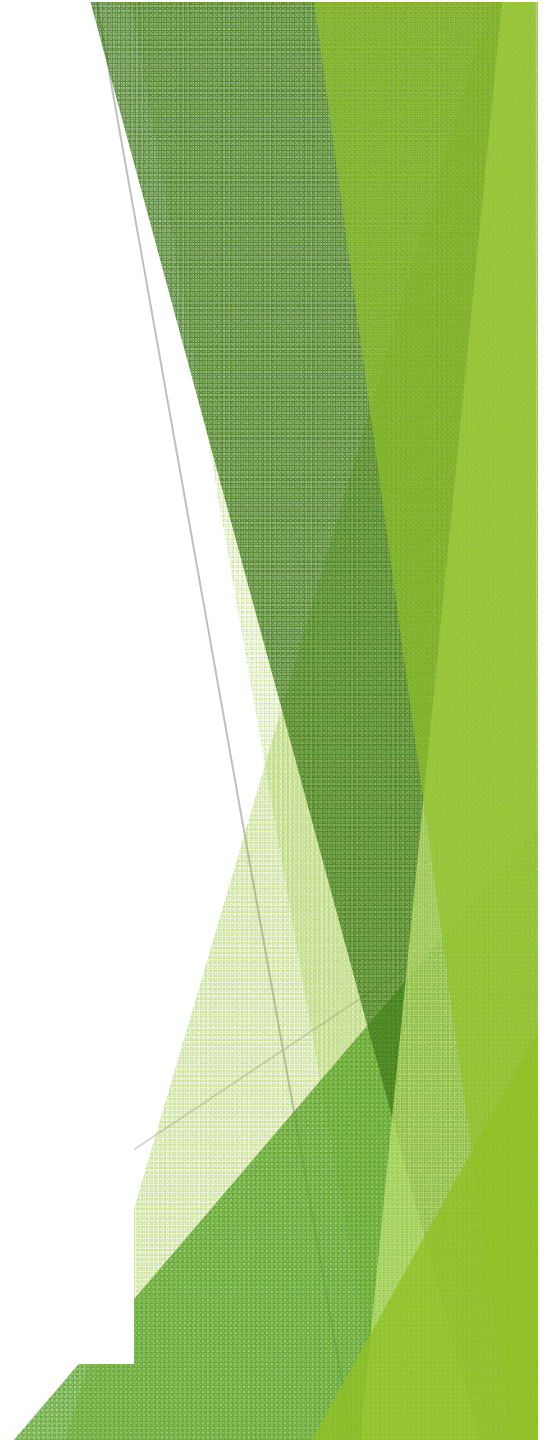
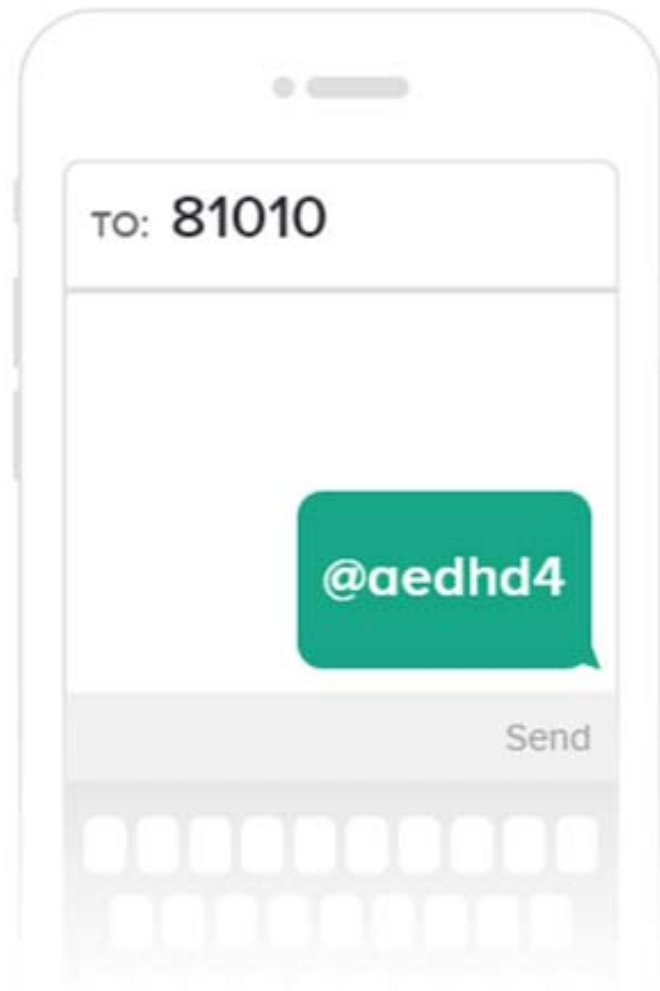

What Do I Need for 4 Year College Admissions?

A-G Requirements

A: History: 2 years required

B: English: 4 years required

C: Math: 3 years including IM3 or higher

D: Lab Science: 2 years Biology AND Chemistry or Physics

E: Language Other Than English - 2 years required

F: Visual & Performing Arts - 1 year required—[check your transcript](#)

G: College Preparatory Elective - 1 year required

2.0 minimum GPA (A-G 10-11 grades only) required for CSU application

3.0 minimum GPA (A-G 10-11 grades only) required for UC application

Must have C-'s or higher to apply

- UC campuses require the Writing portion of the SAT or ACT.
- Subject Tests may be recommended for certain majors and UC campuses.
- *National Merit*: Juniors will find out later this semester if they are a Semi-Finalist or Commended student.

Do I Need Summer School?

Yes, if...

- ▶ You have less than 130 credits you **MUST** take summer school.
- ▶ You want to repeat a D or F grade.
- ▶ You have an impacted schedule due to a program.

What are the summer school options?

1. **Rio Americano HS**
 - a. Monday - Thursday, 8am to 3pm
 - b. June 15 - July 2 only
 - c. Work is done online through Apex program. You're required to attend class.
2. **Independent Study (Sylvan Middle School on Auburn Blvd):**
 - a. Students are given an appointment time Monday - Thursday, 8am to 3pm
 - b. Session 1: June 15 - July 2
 - c. Session 2: July 2- July 23
 - d. Paper packet option: Meet with teacher 1 time per week for 1 hour and work is done at home.
 - e. Online option: Work is done at home online using Apex program, but ALL TESTS MUST BE COMPLETED AT SYLVAN.
3. **Seat Based Summer School (San Juan HS on Greenback Ln):**
 - a. Monday - Thursday, 8am to 3pm, Attend each day
 - b. Session 1 (semester 1): June 15 - July 2
 - c. Session 2 (semester 2): July 6- July 23
4. **Options For Youth Charter School**
 - a. You must enroll in person at OFY. Turn in your application and transcript to OFY, not Rio.

Plan Wisely...

- ▶ Balance between easy and difficult classes.
- ▶ What else is going on during Senior year?
 - ▶ College applications
 - ▶ SAT/ACT testing
 - ▶ AP Tests in May
 - ▶ Part-time job or volunteer
 - ▶ Sports
- ▶ Grades are very important in 12th grade
- ▶ Colleges will be looking at your senior year grades, and the courses you're taking
- ▶ Students have had college acceptances rescinded due to poor senior grades

Choosing Your Courses

- ▶ Seniors must have at least 5 classes
- ▶ Choosing courses for next year:
 - ▶ **English 4:** Choose either CSU-ERWC or AP Literature
 - ▶ **American Government** (or AP)--one semester
 - ▶ **Economics** (or AP)--one semester
 - ▶ **Health**—one semester (if not yet completed)
 - ▶ **Social Studies**—one semester (if not yet completed)
 - ▶ **4th year of Math** is recommended for college admissions
 - ▶ **Visual & Performing Art** (if not yet completed)
 - ▶ Fulfill any remaining graduation requirements

New Courses Available to Seniors

- ▶ Physiology & Anatomy
- ▶ Film & Literature: Elective only for high school requirements
- ▶ QRAT: Quantitative Reasoning with Advanced Mathematical Topics (must have completed IM3). Previously called ESM.
- ▶ Russian for Heritage Learners 2
- ▶ AP Spanish Literature (will also continue to offer AP Spanish Lang)
- ▶ CTE Courses

Step 1: Complete the form.
